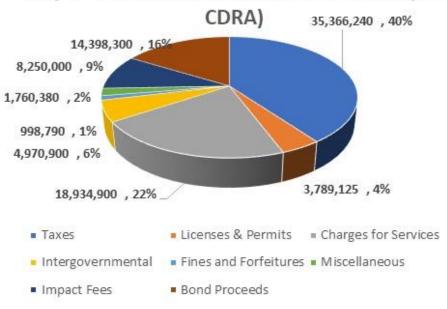

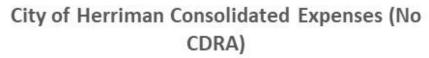
Overall Revenues - FY2025

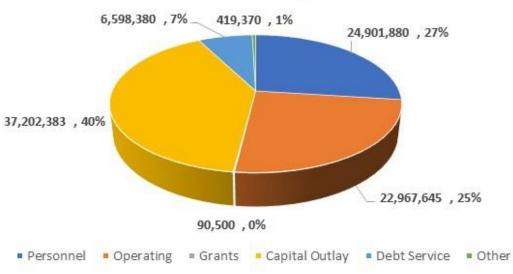
City of Herriman Consolidated Revenues (No



- Total City-wide revenues \$88.5 million
- Capital project bond \$14.4 million (1st year)
- ► Water charges for services 1 \$2 million (15%) (13% increase plus growth)
- ► Sales tax and property tax 3% increase
- Overall "new" revenue (general fund) \$462K (2%)

Overall Expenditures - FY2025

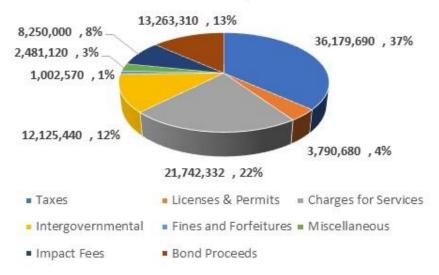




- ► Total City-wide expenses \$97.7 million
- Capital projects (city-wide) \$37.2 million (40%)
- Personnel \$24.9 million (27%) (no additional FTE's)
- Operating \$23 million (25%)

Overall Revenues - FY2026

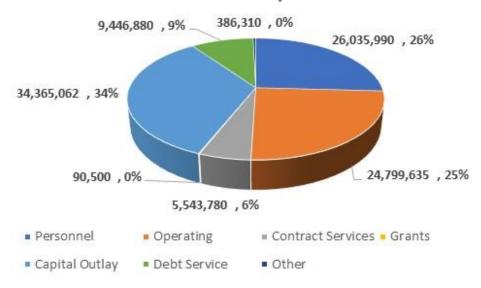
City of Herriman Consolidated Revenues (No CDRA)



- Total City-wide revenues \$98.8 million
- Capital project bond \$13.3 million (2nd year)
- Water charges for services + \$2.7 million (18%) (13% increase plus growth)
- ► Sales tax and property tax 3% increase
- Overall "new" revenue (general fund) \$500K (2%)

Overall Expenditures - FY2026

City of Herriman Consolidated Expenses (No CDRA)



- ► Total City-wide expenses \$100.7 million
- Capital projects (city-wide) \$34.4 million (34%)
- Personnel \$26 million (26%) (no additional FTE's)
- Operating \$24.8 million (25%)

Major Initiatives

- ▶ Pavement Management/road improvements \$783K increase (42%) (2.6 million total)
 - ► Overall streets budget 28% increase
- Funding for operation of community center (facilities) \$68K
- Street light replacement and repair funds Additional \$30K (\$141K total)
- Additional contract engineering funds (\$25K) (\$75K total)
- ► Water Additional water purchases for "hardness" \$500K

Capital Projects

- ► Total (2025 and 2026) \$74.9 million
- ► Capital projects bond \$27.7 million
 - ► MDA and reimbursement agreement obligations
 - ▶ 6400 West improvements (MDA) \$14.2 million
 - ► Hidden Oaks open space improvements \$4.4 million
- ▶ 7300 West extension (state grant) \$7.7 million
- ▶ 6000 W widening \$3.4 million
- ► Fire Station 103 replacement \$6.3 million
- ► Playground replacements \$320K
- Community Center remodel (first phases) \$404K
